Group A: The Ghost with One Black Eye

Task:

Below is the skeleton of the story you will be telling in the workshop. <u>Before the workshop</u>, read through the skeleton several times so you know what happens. (It will help if you read this <u>aloud</u>.)

Then <u>put the text away</u> and say the skeleton again. Do this <u>aloud</u>. (It will help if you have a real person to tell this to. If not, imagine someone – and tell them.)

Don't be surprised if *your* story is different to *mine* – this is what a storyteller does.

You now know the story!

Skeleton

(Tip: before telling, show that "ein blaues Auge" is a **black** eye.)

Baby's favourite drink – apple juice No apple juice on table Baby: I want my apple juice, and I want it NOW!

Father:

I'll go to cellar for your apple juice Went down stairs – was dark Opened cellar door – was darker

Heard voice: I AM THE GHOST WITH ONE BLACK EYE Ran upstairs: I don't want to go down there any more! Baby: But I want my apple juice, and I want it NOW!

Mother - same

Baby: But I want my apple juice, and I want it NOW!

Big brother – same

Baby: But I want my apple juice, and I want it NOW!

Big sister – same

Baby: But I want my apple juice, and I want it NOW!

Baby goes down – it is dark Opens cellar door – is darker

Hears voice: I AM THE GHOST WITH ONE BLACK EYE

Baby: Well, I'll give you TWO black eyes if you stop me getting my apple juice!

Ghost was never heard or seen again.
